Habit:	Compact rounding habit 1-2' x 1-2' in 5 years (Ultimately 2' x 2' untrimmed).
Propagation:	Semi ripe softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best in full sun to light shade in well draining soil.
Additional Comments:	Passed - USDA Cereal Rust Disease Trials in MN. Added to Federal Register of approved varieties.
Uses:	Container Specimens, Garden Specimen, Landscape Plantings.

2 Gallon:	24 months from a 2.5" liner (Spring Planting).
