<b>Habit:</b>	Low spreading habit become vase shaped with maturity. 2' x 4' in 5 years.
<b>Propagation:</b>	Semi ripe softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Best in full sun to light shade in well draining soil.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Foliage color is great in early spring.
<b>Uses:</b>	Container Specimens, Garden Specimen, Landscape Plantings.

<b>1 Gallon:</b>	<b>3 months from a 2.5" liner (Spring Planting).</b>
<b>2 Gallon:</b>	<b>12 months from a 2.5" liner (Spring Planting).</b>
