<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Thuja occidentalis</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	PP 21,967.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	USDA Zone 5-8. (-20°F or -28°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Foliage selection.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	N/A.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Evergreen aromatic, bright yellow-gold foliage, year round.
<b>Habit:</b>	Tight upright pyramidal habit becoming conical with maturity. 8' x 4' in 10 years. (Ultimately 20' x 5' untrimmed).
<b>Propagation:</b>	Mature winter cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Best grown in full sun in moist well drained soils.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Dislikes dry conditions – this may lead to foliage burn. Color holds well in winter temperatures. Sport from industry mainstay, T. Emerald Green ('Smaragd').
<b>Uses:</b>	Container Specimens, Garden Specimen, Landscape Plantings. Hedging.

<b>1 Gallon:</b>	<b>3 months from a 2.5" liner (Spring Planting).</b>
<b>2 Gallon:</b>	<b>12 months from a 2.5" liner (Spring Planting).</b>

<b>Closest Variety:</b> T. Emerald Green ('Smaragd')	<b>Key Differences:</b> ✓ 'Janed Gold' golden foliage <b>vs.</b> mid green foliage. ✓ 'Janed Gold' tight pyramidal habit <b>vs.</b> tight pyramidal habit. ✓ 'Janed Gold' hold color well in winter <b>vs.</b> holds color well in winter.
